CHAPTER I

THE PROBLEM AND METHOD OF PROCEDURE

I. THE PROBLEM

Statement of the problem. This study is made in an attempt to discover if there is in existence a home court advantage in the Indiana High School Athletic Association sectionals, regionals, semi-finals, and state final tourneys from 1936 to and including 1949, and, if so, in what way these advantages do exist. Many possible factors will be listed, but all the factors will come under the title Home Court Advantages giving a percentage in favor of or against the home team. This in turn may bring up the question, "Should these tourneys be played on a neutral floor?"

Importance of the study. Many times during the Indiana High School Athletic Association series of tourneys the remark, "No wonder they always win; they are on their home floor," can be heard. To the majority of spectators and to some coaches this seems to be a logical statement; however, it is sometimes used for an alibi in defeat and for many other reasons.

Because no studies concerning this problem is available for our Indiana High School Athletic Association tourney series, this is the subject chosen for the thesis problem.

II. DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Indiana High School Athletic Association.

The I. H. S. A. A. was organized as a purely voluntary association in 1903 by a small group of high school principals in order that inter-school athletic contests might be carried on under fair competition and honest dealings. This organization, like all other worth-while organizations, was created out of a real need because inter-school athletic contests prior to its formation were conducted in a very unfair manner. In games players were used who were ineligible as students and sometimes who were not students at all. Players were frequently injured by the rough tactics of opponents, and not only did the sport suffer but educational interest as well. The association recognized the problems that were confronting it at the time of its formation and immediately began to formulate rules and policies that would eliminate these evil practices and would place athletic contests on a fair basis. The I. H. S. A. A. has enjoyed a substantial growth because it has successfully met the needs and demands of its membership. No high school suspended from the association or who has withdrawn voluntarily from the association has remained out of the association at the end of the period of suspension. This fact is evidence that our association is functioning properly and that the principals of the various high schools are satisfied with the services that the I. H. S. A. A. renders.¹

Sectionals. A meeting of teams within a certain county or group of counties of the state. Sectionals total 64 in number, and there are from 7 to 16 teams entered in each. The sites of these tourneys are arranged by the Indiana High School

Athletic Association. From each of these sectionals there can be only one winning team which advances to the regionals of the tourney series.

Regionals. A meeting of sectional winners within a certain district of the state. These regionals total 16 in number, and there are 4 teams entered in each. The sites of the tourneys are again set by the Indiana High School Athletic Association. There can be only one winner for each of these regionals and these winners advance to the semi-finals of the tourney series.

Semi-finals. A meeting of regional winners within a certain part of the state. These semi-finals total 4 in number, and there are 4 teams entered in each. The sites are set by the Indiana High School Athletic Association. Only one winner from each advances to the state finals held in Indianapolis.

State finals. A meeting of semi-final winners within the state for the state championship.

III. LIMITATION OF PROBLEM

State of Indiana. The problem has been limited to the state of Indiana because all states do not have the same type of procedure to determine their state champion.

Time element. This problem is limited because it covers only a period of 13 years from 1936 to and including 1949.

IV. METHOD

The Indiana High School Athletic Association Handbooks were used to get the name of the city in which the tourney was held and also the winner of each tourney. All this information was charted by year, name of home team, school or city, winner of tourney and whether it was a home team, a visitor, or, whether any home team was in the tourney, and special remarks about tourneys. This was done for sectionals, regionals, and semi-finals. The state tournament from 1936 to and including 1949 was held in the Butler Field House or at the Coliseum during the years of the war; therefore there was no home team and little information concerning this will be given.

All cities were then arranged according to the district in which the tourney played, and a chart was made from the above mentioned charts placing these schools in their sectional on one chart and numbering the charts 1 to 64. This gives the rotation plan along with other information. If one team changed from one sectional to another this change was recorded under Remarks. Also mentioned is where certain tourneys were eliminated and new ones installed because of changes in schools. Each sectional chart shows the number of tourneys won by home teams and the number won by visitors. These factors have been

mathematically computed to get the percentage of wins for each sectional; this percentage then is the home court advantage percentage. One large chart showing number of sectionals won, lost, and percentage of each is shown; also shown is the overall number of sectionals won, lost, and percentage.

The handbook was again used to get the name of the city or school holding the regional and this information was charted as to year, place held, winner, whether the winner was home team, visitor, or whether no home team participated, and remarks. All cities holding regional tourneys then placed according to the district of the state and a chart was made showing all schools in a region holding regional tourneys. These charts were numbered 1 to 16. They show also the rotation plan and all the statistical information needed to set up a home court advantage percentage. A chart showing all regionals and the information concerning each was completed. The same chart was used for sectionals.

The same method used for the regional was used in compiling the semi-final results.

Many of the larger cities having more than one school made it difficult to get the court on which the games were played so letters were sent to sport writers of these cities for the information. These sport writers game information that could not be found in the handbooks.

A special trip to the Indiana High School Athletic

Association office also helped in solving many problems as to the court and home school in many tourneys.

V. REVIEW RELATED LITERATURE

There have been a few newspaper and magazine articles written about the advantage enjoyed by teams playing at home; but none of these articles dealt with out Indiana tournament. These articles were about college basketball.

CHAPTER II

REVIEW OF SECTIONALS, REGIONALS, AND SEMI-FINALS RESULTS

I. SECTIONALS

In Table I all sectionals in the state are listed by number from 1 to 64, under the headings Sectional Number, Won, Lost, and Percentage record for each, from this table we can easily see at a glance how each sectional compares with any other in the state. We can also see by the total results how any sectional compares with the average percentage.

The sectional number is the number of the sectional in the appendix. In the Won column is the number of times the home team has won a tourney. In the Lost column is the number of times the home team lost the tourney. Under Percentage is the home team advantage percentage. Tables II, III, and IV are all read the same as Table I.

In the discussion which follows all sectionals will be grouped. Those having a better than .700 per cent record will be put in group I, those better than .500 per cent in group II, those better than .300 per cent in group III, and the remainder in group IV. Each group will then be discussed.

Group I. Group I contains sectional numbers 13, 15, 16, 17, 26, 31, 39, 40, 47, 49a, 50, 59, 61, 63, and 64. These sectionals have a large percentage of home court winners.

They seem to be dominated by only having one large school in their tourney therefore they have better conditions to play under; they usually have coaches with more experience and play tougher schedules than the remainder of the teams in their tourney; they have, because of larger enrollment, more boys to choose from than their tourney opponents, they have no rotational plan to go through and they hold the tourneys at home year after year.

Now let us consider each tourney. (See Table II). In sectional 13 a .789 per cent was the record mainly because Bedford and Mitchell are the winners. A rotation plan was used until 1946, and then Bedford was given the sectional without rotation. Bedford is the largest school and Mitchell second. No other school in the tourney has a large enough enrollment or plays a schedule which can compare to Bedford or Mitchell. Conditions in this sectional may not be as large a factor as enrollment. Coaching may be a factor in this tourney.

Sectional 15 has a .714 percentage record. This tourney is held at Seymour. Seymour is the largest school with best conditions. They also play a tough schedule compared with the remainder of the teams in the tourney.

Sectional 16 has a .786 percentage record. This sectional differs from the remainder of group I because two large schools are in this tourney. Schedules are about the same, and coaching likewise. Jeffersonville and New Albany are the

dominating teams. All of Jeffersonville's victories were at home while New Albany's were 3 at home and 3 away. In this sectional the home court seems to give a definite advantage.

Sectional 17 has a .714 percentage. Having been held at Madison except for two years, Madison is the most powerful team of this tourney. Schedule, enrollment, and facilities are all in their favor.

Sectional 26, another .714 percentage, was held at Anderson each time. Again Anderson dominates the tourney because of schedule, enrollment, and facilities. Small teams have upset this power team, but only because of the large school being over confident or lack of being up for their tourney game.

Sectional 31 has a .714 percentage and is held yearly at Crawfordsville. All advantages are the same as for Madison and Anderson.

Sectional 35 has a .857 percentage. The team here is Jefferson of Laffeyette which holds the same advantages as Sectionals 17, 26, and 31.

Sectional 39 has a .857 percentage. The team here is Logansport which holds the same advantages of Sectionals 17, 26, 31, and 35.

Sectional 43 has a .928 percentage. This tournament is played in Gary and all Gary schools have the same home court.

Sectional 47 held at South Bend has a .786 percentage. This tourney has many large schools, therefore schedule and

enrollment do not seem to affect the outcome. Also all teams use John Adams Gym for their home games. Central has won the most times, but only material may be the difference.

Sectional 49a has a .750 percentage but is no longer in operation. It was held at Columbia City for four years with Columbia City winning all except one.

Sectional 58 has a .714 percentage for Marion, which holds the tourney yearly. Schedule, enrollment, and facilities all favor Marion.

Sectional 59 has a .846 percentage for Kokomo, which lost only one tourney until its gym burned. This school also has all the advantages given large schools who hold the tourney yearly.

Sectional 61 is the only sectional with 1.000 per cent in favor of the home team. Muncie Fieldhouse is the scene of all tourney games, with Burriss and Central also using it as their home floor. They hold the advantage, as do all the other schools listed before. Central has won 6 times while Burriss has won 8 times. No other school in this tourney has ever managed to win a sectional.

Sectional 63 is another tourney with a .714 per cent record for New Castle, which is the team to watch in their sectional. All advantages favor them.

Sectional 64 has a .786 percentage and is held at Richmond. The advantages held by Richmond are the same as all the

other tourneys with a .786 percentage.

Group II. Group II contains Sectional Numbers 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25, 29, 33, 34, 37, 38, 44, 50, 53, and 57. These sectionals have a per cent which indicates that half or more than half the time the home team is the winner. (See Table III). In this group there are 3 classes of sectionals'. (1) those with more than one large school; (2) those in which schools are about the same in enrollment; and (3) those which have the rotation plan with a yearly change in the site for the tourney. Coaching and enrollment in these sectionals are about even. The facilities seem to be the deciding factor along with the type of schedule played during the season.

Sectional 1 has a .692 percentage and is held at Central of Evansville. This sectional falls in class 1. The results were above the average. No advantage is found in schedules or enrollment; the home floor the determining factor.

Sectional 4 has a .500 percentage and is held at Boonville. This sectional is in class 2, in which the enrollment, schedules, and floor all seem to help in the advantage, although the records show only the home team being victorious half the time.

Sectional 5 has a .572 percentage held at Vincennes. This sectional is in class 1. Vincennes has the advantage in

schedules, enrollment, and facilities.

Sectional 6 has a .643 percentage held at Washington. This sectional is in class 1. Washington High was a big winner, but since the organization of Washington Catholic, which has reduced the enrollment at Washington High, the results differ. Here schedule and facilities favor Washington High.

Sectional 7 another .643 percentage held at Jasper since their new gymnasium; before it was on a rotation plan. Jasper has the advantage in facilities, other seem to be equal. This sectional is in class 1.

Sectional 9 has a .600 percentage and is held at Terre Haute. This tourney is now held at Indiana State College Gymnasium. This sectional is in class 1. All large schools in this tourney are city schools.

Sectional 10 has a .500 percentage, held at Brazil and Spencer. This sectional is in class 2 with enrollment and schedule favoring Brazil, although the home team does not seem to carry a large advantage on its home court.

Sectional 4, another .500 percentage, is in class 2 and is on a rotation plan. Scheduling, enrollment, and facilities all seem to be the same, as is more or less proven out by results.

Sectional 18, a .572 percentage, is held at Aurora and Lawrenceburg. This sectional is in class 2 and schedule, enrollment, and facilities are about equal throughout the section-

al. Home court is a small advantage.

Sectional 19 has a .572 percentage and is held at Batesville. This sectional also is in class 2. All advantages are about even.

Sectional 20 has a .643 percentage held at Greensburg. This sectional is in class 1, and Greensburg seems to have the enrollment and facilities to its advantage.

Sectional 21 has a .572 percentage and is held at Connorsville. Schedule and facilities all are in favor of Connorsville. This sectional is not in the above mentioned classes.

Sectional 22 has a .643 percentage and is held at Rushville. This sectional is not in the above mentioned class because it, like Connorsville, is the only large school in its tourney. Schedule, enrollment, and facilities are in its favor.

Sectional 24 has a .643 percentage and is held at Franklin. Again this tourney does not fall into a class but is like Connorsville and Rushville.

Sectional 25 has a .500 percentage and is held at Greenfield. Classed in group 2, enrollment is not quite as large a factor as other tourneys in this group; however, results show Greenfield is victorious only half the time.

Sectional 29 has a .643 percentage and is held at Greencastle. This tourney is not in a class mentioned above as only

one large school is present. All advantages favor Greencastle.

Sectional 33 has a .643 percentage and is held at Lebanon. It is the same as sectional 21, 22, 24, and 29.

Sectional 34 has a .643 percentage and is held at Frankfort. It is the same as sectionals 21, 22, 24, 29, and 33.

Sectional 37 has a .500 percentage and is held at Monticello. Classed in 2, all the advantages seem to be even. Results seem to indicate this is true.

Sectional 38 has a .500 percentage. This tourney is on a rotation plan between Delphi and Flora, in class 2, all advantages are about even in the tourney.

Sectional 44 has a .500 percentage and held at Michigan City and LaPorte. Class 1, schedule, facilities, and enrollment are about even.

Sectional 50 has a .500 percentage and is held at Kendallville. Classed in 2, Kendallville has an enrollment advantage and a home floor advantage although winning only .500 per cent of the time.

Sectional 53 has a .572 percentage and is held at Huntington. No classification and all advantages favor Huntington High.

Sectional 57 has a .643 percentage and is held at Wabash. It is the same as sectionals 20, 21, 22, 24, 29, 33, and 53.

Group III. This group contains Sectionals 8, 11, 30,

32, 42, and 55a. This group is small, and results show one-third of the time the home team came through its tourney. (See Table IV). These tourney have one class (1) where one large school is present.

Sectional 8 has a .429 percentage and is held at Sullivan, class 1. Why these results have been this way cannot be explained. All advantages seem to be with school at home, yet they come through only one-fourth of the time. This type of sectional indicates that material and coaching have the largest influence on checking the home team's advantages of facilities and schedule.

Sectional 11 has a .429 percentage and is held at Linton, although on a rotation plan. Bloomfield offers hardest competition to Linton although others come through at times.

Sectional 30 has a .429 percentage and is held at Attica. Classed in 1 it is the same as sectionals 8 and 30.

Sectional 42 has a .429 percentage and is held at Hammond. Classed in 1 it is the same as sectionals 8, 30, and 32.

Sectional 55a has a .300 percentage and is held at Decatur. Established in 1940, classed in 1, and is the same as sectionals 8, 30, and 32.

Group IV. This contains sectionals 2, 3, 12, 23, 27, 28, 36, 41, 45, 46, 48, 49b, 51, 52, 54, 56, 60, and 62. These

sectionals have very poor percentage. These sectionals can be divided into 2 classes: (1) the sectional with more than one school about the same size and on rotation plan; (2) the sectionals not on rotation plan, but schools about the same in size. (See Table V).

Sectional 2 has a .143 percentage and is classed as 1. This tourney rotates between Tell City and Cannelton. Although Tell City has been the winner seven times, they have won only twice on their home court.

Sectional 3 has a .000 percentage. This tourney is in class 1. It rotates between four schools. Owensville, Oakland City, Princeton, and Fort Branch. A home team here has never won a sectional. All schools concerned have approximately the same enrollment, schedule, and facilities, consequently creating no home advantage.

Sectional 12 has a .286 percentage and is held at Martinsville and Bloomington. Classed in 2, these two large schools have good facilities, schedule and enrollment. A strong rivalry exists between these two schools, giving the home floor little if any advantage.

Sectional 23 has a .286 percentage and is classed as 2. It is held at Shelbyville, which, with Columbus, make up the largest schools in this tourney. They have won 10 tourneys together, but Shelbyville has only 4 to its credit. Here enrollment is the dominating factor.

Sectional 27 is held at Technical of Indianapolis until transferred to Butler Field House in 1945. The percentage is .111. Schools are in class 1, when enrollment gets as high as at Technical no advantage has been proven.

Sectional 28 has a .000 percentage and is held at Danville. It is in class 1. This tourney was held at Central Normal Gymnasium and Canterbury Gymnasium the same place. The college changed its name in 1946.

Sectional 36 has a .214 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney rotates between Fowler, Otterbein, Boswell, Ambia, and Oxford.

Sectional 41 has a .181 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney rotates with Rensselaer and Morocco, until moved to St. Joseph Gymnasium.

Sectional 45 has a .257 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney rotates between Rochester and Winamac. Of the seven years it was held at Rochester, the home team won 5 times.

Sectional 46 has a .286 percentage and is in class 2. This tourney is held at Plymouth. All schools in this tourney are about the same size and the home floor has proved no advantage.

Sectional 48 has a .214 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney has been dominated by Elkhart although on a rotational basis. Therefore the size of school seems to control more than the home floor.

Sectional 49b has a .275 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney is held at Warsaw.

Sectional 51 has a .143 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney meets at Auburn, Garrett, Angola, and Butler.

Sectional 52 has a .214 percentage and is in class 2. This tourney is held at Fort Wayne and the North Side Gymnasium is used. Due to all the Fort Wayne schools being the same size and playing some of their regular scheduled games at the North Side Gymnasium, this tourney record cannot correctly show the home court advantage.

Sectional 54 has a .143 percentage and is in class 2. This tourney is held at Bluffton. Why the records shows a poor home court advantage cannot rightly be determined, because all advantages should indicate Bluffton to control this tourney.

Sectional 56 has a .000 percentage and is in class 2. This tourney is held at Hartford City, and is the same in results as sectional 54.

Sectional 60 has a .072 percentage and is in class 1. This sectional rotates between Sheridan, Tipton, and Noblesville.

Sectional 62 has a .286 percentage and is in class 1. This tourney was held at Winchester until 1945, when it was moved to Farmland. Winchester was able to win only three times on its own floor, and Farmland only once.

II. REGIONALS

In Table VI all regionals are shown under the headings of: Regional Number, Won, Lost, No Home Team, and Percentages. We can see by this Table easily how one team compares with the other. These regionals can be divided into two groups, one--those with percentages above .500 per cent and two--those below .500 per cent. By looking at the appendix, each regional results are shown.

These tourneys are held on the home floor of large schools throughout the state. These schools are all in large cities. Eleven of the seventeen regionals show a home floor advantage. The regionals usually have all large schools entered; therefore the percentage shows a home floor advantage as these schools which compete in the regional all have good schedules, coaching, and a large student body from which to pick players.

III. SEMI-FINALS

Table VII shows the results of the semi-final tourneys. These tournaments are now held at Indiana University, Purdue University, Butler University, and the Muncie Field House. Only the Muncie Field House, which is the home floor of Central and Burriss, has a home court percentage. Burriss has won twice and Central has won once.

CHAPTER III

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

I. SUMMARY

Comparing the groups we find group I has a .783 percentage. Group II has .579, group III .409, and group IV a .151. Now why does group I have such a high percentage compared with the other groups? First, all the teams which are home teams and have such a record show the record can be contributed to quite a few advantage factors. First, all the schools have the largest enrollment in these sectionals; they play better schedules; they have better facilities; and they have coaches with more experience because they hire coaches who have been successful in other schools and who have their systems of coaching well organized. Second, these coaches have assistant coaches and a Junior High program with coaches which provide a feeder system. The small schools have in general only one man in charge of all their activities. The only exceptions to this are in sectionals 16 and 47, the New Albany-Jeffersonville and the South Bend sectionals, where more than one large school is present.

Schools in Group II have the enrollment advantage over their opponent and are not quite as large as schools in group I. Their schedules are better, and facilities are better.

The coaching is not quite the same as group I, although coaches with more experience who also have proved themselves successful in smaller schools are found mostly in these schools. In general, the home team has the advantage.

Group III has those schools which have a small advantage in enrollment over their tourney rivals. Their schedules are a little better, but the facilities are only slightly better. Coaching in these schools is approximately the same as their tourney opponents. There are only a small group of these schools in the state.

Now for group IV. These sectionals have more schools entered that have the same schedules, advantages as to coaching, facilities, and enrollment as any team in the tourney and have just as good as the team holding the tourney. Since more than one large school is present, the results are quite different from groups I and II, where usually only one large school is entered.

II. CONCLUSIONS

Comparing the sectionals where only one large school is present, as found in Table II, it is shown that the large school is the victor the greater number of the games. In these tourneys, enrollment is the most influential factor in the home court advantage; however, scheduling and facilities do affect the results.

In the sectionals, where more than one large school is present, where schools have about the same enrollment, or where schools have rotation plans, as shown in Table III, these schools are victorious on their home court .579 per cent of the time. The advantage for these schools lies in their facilities.

The tourneys where one large school is present but small schools have the facilities available to them the same as the large school, the percentage is .409. In this group, where this condition is met, the home school advantage is very small. Table IV, illustrates the results.

In the sectionals where more than one school of the same size is on a rotation plan, and schools of the same size not on rotation plan, the percentage is .194. In these tourneys enrollment has the greatest influence on the outcome. Facilities are approximately the same where schools are on rotation plan.

The overall percentage of .516 shows the home school to be the victor and having an definite advantage. This is shown in Table I.

To better illustrate the home court advantage, further studies could be made. For example, the number of games won and lost by the home team in their tourneys taken for certain number of years might give a better result.
